1. Verbs with **-O, -CH, -SH, -SS, -X,** or **-Z** at the end, we have to add **-ES** in the third person.

- * go - goes
- * catch - catches
- * wash - washes
- * kiss - kisses
- * fix - fixes
- * buzz - buzzes
