| You work | Do you work? | You don't work |
| He works | Does he work? | He doesn't work |
| She works | Does she work? | She doesn't work |
| It Works | Does it Work? | It doesn't work |
| We work | Do we work? | We don't work |
| You work | Do you work? | You don't work |
| They work | Do they work? | They don't work |
